

Important Update - April 8, 2020

Since all collective assemblies are canceled till further notice.

Here is what we can do:

- **Sunday service** will be live-streamed through the website at 9:00 am. Please tune in and worship along with us. Don't be passive. Participate by singing with the song leader, reading along in the Scripture, praying with the prayer, commune as directed at the proper time, and say "amen" to the teaching/preaching. **Note:** that **no one** will be allowed to enter the building. Please stay home.
- Note this re: Livestream:
 - a. If you don't hear sound, check to see if there is an "x" by your volume button. Remove the "x"
 - b. The streaming company notified us that they have upgraded their system. However, **if the streaming should falter again**, wait till about **2:30 pm** and there should be **a link** that will take you to a video recording of the service. You can worship together at that time.
- **Communion** supplies are available. Contact your **zone leader**, one of the **elders** or come by the **building between 10 am and 2 pm on Saturday** to get what is needed for your household. During the live-stream, we will commune at the proper time.
- **Contribution** may be given (1) through the website "online giving"; or (2) via the mobile app [contact us for instructions]; or (3) you can mail it to the church; or (4) you can contact your zone leader or elder for pick up; or (5) you may bring it by the building **between 10 am and 2 pm on Saturday**.
- For those **without internet access**. The **television program** will be designed to conduct a worship service. You can gather your household together and participate by singing with the song leader, reading along in the Scripture, praying with the prayer and communing together as directed by Bro. Hayes during the program. Also say "amen" to the teaching/preaching.
- **Wednesday evening Bible Class** will be streamed at 6:30 pm. A study guide should be available on the website by Tuesday, 2:00 pm.
- **Attendance:** please indicate your participation in the live-streamed service by (1) sending a message via the website [use the "more" button to get to the "contact" button and input your name.]; or (2) by emailing us at **ejcofc@eastjacksoncofc.org**; or (3) calling the church office and leave a message.
- Stay in touch with one another via our zone group contacts. Call and check on the sick and shut-ins in the zone. Communicate (in a positive way) on social media.
- Please communicate with your zone leaders, deacons, elders and minister if there are any concerns or special needs that arise. And most of all, let us continue to pray for God's guidance and healing hand.
