

Don't Allow Frequency To Minimize The Fervently

The institution of the Lord's Supper is recorded by Matthew (26:26-29), Mark (14:22-25) and Luke (22:19ff). The frequency of partaking of it is found in the example of Christians of the first century. They observed it weekly and so do we (Acts 20:7). Each time we partake of this "communion" of the body and blood of Christ (1 Cor. 10:16), we must do so with fervent focus on its meaning. Fervently focus on the fact that it is a Dedication (1 Cor. 11:25 - this cup is the new covenant of My blood); a Proclamation (1 Cor. 11:26a - you proclaim the Lord's death); and is in Anticipation (1 Cor. 11:26b - until He comes)


