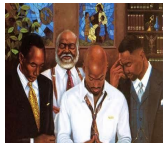


GOSPEL MEETING

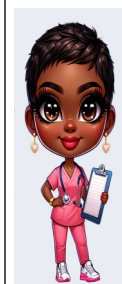
