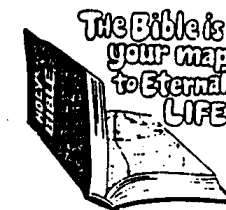

Mission Minded Members

Let us refocus on a primary focus of the followers of Christ: to save souls (*Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, Matthew 28:19*), and to keep the saved, saved (*Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you, Matthew 28:20*).

As a congregation we have framed this task as Being About The Business of **Bridging, Bringing, Building, Benefitting**. This is a mission that Jesus initiated during His earthly ministry and that He has commissioned His followers to continue. Since He is the only way to the Father, (John 14:6), we must be about the business of sharing the saving gospel (Romans 1:16) with the world that they might hear it, obey it and be saved through it. But this is a partnership. We are *workers together with God* who plant and water and look to God to give the increase, (1 Cor. 3:5-9).

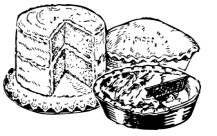

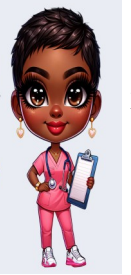
