

## HOLY HUNGER



*Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled, Matthew 5:6 (nkjv)*

We know that our survival in the physical life depends, among other things, on our being fed and nourished on a daily basis. Yes, in extreme circumstances, individuals have survived for days and even weeks without food. But eventually, without food, a person will die. Our bodies have a natural desire for nourishment. We call that desire "hunger". Additionally, a couple of facts about hunger should be noted.

- 1) When the hunger is satisfied, it impacts all parts of the body, even the brain. Our thinking can be impaired if we are not properly nourished. Conversely, we perform and think better when properly nourished.
- 2) What we are hungry for is subject to training and teaching. There may be food that we enjoy and others that we have no appetite for. One person truly enjoys catfish, while another longs for crab legs. One person likes scrambled eggs while another may be lactose intolerant.

**Every Christian should have a holy hunger for righteousness.** We must have a savoring or taste for the things of God, rather than the things of men, Matthew 16:22-23.

Jesus said that we should hunger and thirst after righteousness, or all that in

concluded in God's will. A very important part of the righteousness of God that we

should seek is a healthy appetite for the word of God. Peter tells us that we should

desire the word of God like a babe desires milk (1 Peter 2:2-3).

**Every Christian should "eat in" and "eat out".** As much as we have a choice to prepare meals at home or to eat out at our favorite restaurant, so also we need spiritual "home cooking" by way of daily meditation on the word of God personally and with our family (Psalm 1:2). However, we must also come to the feast prepared for the collective body of Christ, assembled as the church (Hebrews 10:24-25; Acts 2:42; 1 Timothy 4:13). I am referring to the worship services and Bible classes we have available each Sunday and Wednesday.

**Every Christian should end their meal with dessert.** It is customary to end our meals with some sweet commodity like cake or pie. Well, in a way, those who hunger and thirst for God's righteousness will enjoy something sweet after the main meal of serving God in this life. In Revelation 2:7 (see also 22:14), the saints of God were encouraged to be faithful and strong in striving to overcome the trials of this life so that they would be able to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God. After fighting the good fight and finishing our course in this life, receiving a crown (2 Timothy 4:6-) and eating of the tree of life: that will be like having spiritual dessert!


