GOD'S FREIGHT

Feel like God does not care at times? Read Isaiah 63:9, "In all their distress he [GOD] too distressed, and the angel of his presence saved them. In his love and mercy he redeemed them; he lifted them up and carried them all the days of old." Isaiah was referring to God's care for Israel as they Egypt, wandered in the wilderness, and conquered the Promised Land.

Perhaps the ultimate example of God's care for people is Israel in the wilderness. God carried a nation of nearly 3,000,000 souls through a wilderness for 40 years! Israel would need 1,500 tons of food per day, or two freight trains, each a mile long, filled with food. In order to cook, they needed about 4000 tons of wood per day. For water to drink and wash they needed 11,000,000 gallons each day or a freight train of tank cars 1800 miles long!

The miracle of the Red Sea occurred in just one night. WE have the impression that it happened like the movies "The Ten Commandments" portrays. If Israel passed through the sea double file on a narrow path, the line would be 800 miles long and it would have taken 35 days and nights, To pass through in one night, they would to pass through 5000 abreast, creating an opening 3 miles across!. Why just the space required for the campground for this nation in the wilderness has to be 750 square miles, about 2/3 the size of Rhode Island.

What a burden do you have that God can not handle? Your distress is his, "Casting all your care on him because he cares for you." (1Peter5:7)

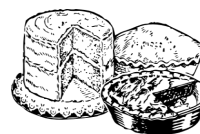


Senior Saints Monthly Luncheon & Meeting on Tuesday, July 14th at 11 am. Fellowship, Fun and Food

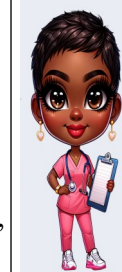
