A Survey Showed:

- (1) When both parents were
active in the work of the
church, 93% of the children remained
faithful.
- (2) When one parent were active , 73% of
the children remined faithful.
- (3) When both parents were marginally
active, their children remained 53:%
of the time.
- (4) When both parents attended
infrequently, only 6 % of their
children continued in the faith.

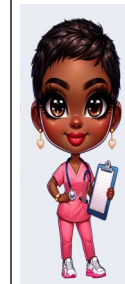
Asking prayers for Bonnnie, Monica &
