

From the Nursing Staff Recently there has been a widespread increase in respiratory infection including:

COVID, RSV and the FLU. Tennessee is one the states where the I infection rate is the

highest. Since December 23rd the Covid rate in Madison County has increased to 25%. The last time our rate was this high was January 2023.

The new Covid variant is JN! (also know as Pirola). This new strain is considered to be more contagious than the previous Omicron variant but is not currently leading to increased hospitalization. But emergency room visits are increasing to the same rate that was seen in January 2023.

PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT THOSE OVER THE AGE OF 65 ARE AT A HIGHER RISK FOR COMPLICATIONS FROM THESE INFECTIONS.

The CDC (Center for Disease Control) states that the recent family holidays gathering and travel have contributed to the increase infection rates and their recommendations are:

- COVID and FLU vaccinations as soon as possible
- Mask wearing in public places

EMBRACING EXCELLENCE IN OUR DISCIPLESHIP

Our theme on last year was Embracing Excellence in 2023 And Beyond. Under that theme we focused on excellence in edification (building one another); in engagement (getting involved in ministry); in evangelism (bringing the lost to Christ); and in elation (praising God with lips and lives). As you will hear in detail in our annual presentation

on today, we continue the theme of Embracing Excellence. The focus for this year is on discipleship.

We have seen that every Christian is a disciple and every disciple has to be a Christian. Acts 11:26 says that the disciples were called Christians first at Antioch. Jesus spoke in John 8:31-32 about us being not just disciples, but disciples indeed. Therefore, we concluded that Jesus wants us to be His disciples to the superlative degree. He wants us to Embrace Excellence In Our Discipleship.

We will focus on excellence in discipleship from four aspects throughout the year. We will begin with the **Deepening of Discipleship**. The goal is to understand what it means to be a disciple of Christ and to grow in our level of commitment to Christ as His disciple.

One of the tools that we will use to accomplish this goal is a special study in our adult Sunday School classes entitled: Following Jesus. The young adult, middle adult and auditorium classes with engage in this study for 13 weeks beginning on Sunday. February 4th.

Afterwards, we will add a focus of the **Duties of Discipleship**. We will move from information into application. James teaches us to not just be hearers of the word, but doers. If we are hearers, but not doers, we deceive ourselves. If we are hearers and doers: this one will be blessed in what he does (James 1:22-25).

After adding the aspect of "duties" to our understanding of "deepening", we will focus on the **Declaration of Discipleship**. Jesus teaches us the aspect of declaration when He told us to go, therefore and make disciples of all the nations, Matthew 28:18-

Finally, we will take a look at **Decisions of Discipleship**. We will learn to evaluate our person strengths and growth areas as disciples, in keeping with the admonition of 2 Corinthians 13:5. Therefore, we have an exciting year ahead in 2024!


